



Rights in Retirement

Campaign Week 24-29 October 2011

Pensioners are now facing a series of attacks on their living standards in areas such as pensions, health care and rising costs of fuel. The NPC has called a Campaign Week during October to highlight our demand for three basic Rights in Retirement:

- *The right to a decent basic state pension, set around £178 a week, which takes everyone out of poverty in older age*
- *The right to be cared for with dignity and respect whether in the NHS or the community, and for the cost of that care to be shared by society as a whole*
- *The right to a warm home, with a Winter Fuel Allowance of £500 per household towards the cost of fuel*

- **Join the National Rally/Lobby of Parliament 26 Oct, 1pm, Committee Rm 14, House of Commons**

- **Sign the Fair Pensions For All and Winter Fuel Allowance petitions**
- **If you cannot get to any of these events, make sure you lobby local MPs during the Campaign Week and organise your own public meetings/protests/street stalls to highlight the issues**
